Due to the idiosyncratic momentum of the developments in the State of Sudan, this article is limited to the proceedings until the signing of Sudan's Comprehensive Peace Agreement between the Government of Sudan (GoS) and the Sudan People's Liberation Movement (SPLM) on January 9th, 2005. The following discourse is then limited to the North/South-Relation and does not cover the endeavour in Dārfūr and parts of Eastern Sudan directly. After a succinct introduction to relevant aspects for the imminent constitution-making-process with references laid down in certain protocols mediated by the protagonists, this essay focuses on assorted issues of Sudan's ongoing constitutional debate. Furthermore, the Article attempts to illustrate alternative concepts of constitutional implementation suitable to Sudan's distinctive needs.
